### **RULES:**

- Stallion Pens must be booked prior to show, please read below
- Show run under NZWRF rules except for non-points classes.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to alter the programme and/or amend the order in which events are run.
- Entry Fees may be refunded at RWRC discretion if a Medical or Veterinary Certificate is provided.
- Amateur cards to be shown at the office prior to show commencing, photocopies forwarded with entries is preferable.
- All dogs to be tied up or on a leash at all times (\$20 fine for dogs off leash during the show) and please pick up dog manure also
- Pleasure classes will be split if there are large entries
- Pens and area around trucks and floats must be cleared of hay and manure before leaving grounds
- Please note there will be no reserving of pens by the show secretary. Due to a limited number of pens the Rotorua Western Riding Club reserve the right to allocate usage of a pen based on first received fully paid entries with the show secretary. Please ensure that you have ticked the box on your entry form to indicate that you wish to be eligible to have usage of a pen allocated.
- Please note that if entries are received by the show secretary prior to the closing date of entries from a club member who has paid for the usage of a pen for the current season they are entitled to their pen.
- Stallion pens will be the last to be allocated; if entries are not received by the show secretary from a stallion competitor by the closing date of entries then these two pens will be tentatively allocated to the next competitor based on first received fully paid entries. If a late entry is received by a stallion competitor then the competitors who have had a stallion pen tentatively allocated will forfeit their pen to the stallion competitor.
- You will be notified after the closing date of entries if you have been allocated a pen or tentatively allocated a stallion pen by the show secretary. - Entries close Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> January 2018 payment must be received either by cheque, cash or with receipt of online payment by this date or prior to the first class of each day with late entry fee included if relevant.
- **NZWRF Approved Safety Helmets.** As of the 1st January 2018 NZWRF will be following ESNZ, NZPCA & RAS to only allow approved safety helmets to be worn in competition. Refer NZWRF Rule SHW320 – Mandatory for youth but optional for adults, except for adult timed events. These helmets will need to be tagged to ensure they meet the new approved helmet standards. Failure to do so, will result in exclusion from classes.
